SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

Five were the survivors of the crew of 23 of the Menin Ridge (2,474 tons); and

The Menin Ridge was owned by the Ridge Steamship Co. The survivors from the Menin Ridge were landed at Gibraltar yesterday.

Menin Ridge (2,474 tons).—Also sunk in Atlantic. Five survivors picked up by the Crown City. Twenty-two other members of the crew believed lost.

MENIN RIDGE.—2,474 tons, of Cardiff, sunk; 20 men lost.

The Ledbury and the Menin Ridge were both sunk in the North Atlantic, and 22 men of the Menin Ridge were lost. An American steamer, the Crown City, rescued the whole crew of 31 from the Ledbury and five survivors from the Menin Ridge.
