Nature of Survey

The *Newcastle* Surveyors report this vessel examined afloat on account of damage through *collision to the bridge bulwarks and stringer plating (p.s.)*

In the Surveyor's opinion the damage, which has not been dealt with on this occasion, does not affect the vessel's efficiency.
