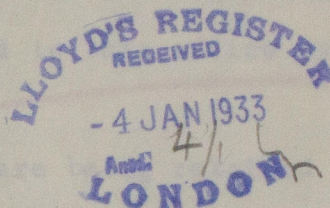

Dear Sir,

With reference to the Convention Freeboard Assignment to the steamer "MENIN RIDGE", I beg to advise you that the marks have now been cut in the vessel's sides, and that the conditions of assignment have been complied with as follows:-

- (1) Two tarpaulins and efficient battening arrangements have been provided for No.3 cargo hatchway on the freeboard deck.
- (2) Efficient means of closing have been provided for all ventilators and air pipes.
- (3) Provision for rigging lifelines in the fore and after wells has been made.
- (4) The hatch covers, tarpaulins, and the fidley grating covers have been put in satisfactory condition.
- (5) The steel plates closing the openings in the bridge front bulkhead have been secured by bolts passing through the plate and bulkhead and spaced 6" apart.

The timber deck cargo freeboard has not been assigned.
