The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/32.)

The 3rd S.S.No.1 will become due 10.39 and a proposal to carry this out sometime before the expiration of the year of grace has been agreed to provided a satisfactory general examination be carried out.

The Rotterdam Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated, 2 shell plates and some deck plating renewed and minor repairs effected.

The foremast, found bent, has been repaired.

A general examination has been carried out.

Some repairs will be required at the special survey but the parts requiring these are efficient meantime.

The Surveyors are of the opinion that the proposed postponement of the Special Survey merits approval.

It is submitted the year of grace be granted.

It is further submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with record of survey 8.39.
