With reference to your freeboard assignment letter
M. 2-9-37 in the case of the s.s. "KONSTANTINOS HADJIPATERAS"
I have now pleasure in forwarding C 12 and C 11b reports.

A bulbplate fore and after 8" x .40" with double
angles 3 x 3 x .36 is fitted in the No. VI hatchway on the
freeboard deck as before the alterations.

Further I may state that the depths of the hatch
beams, as now reported, are from the under side of the hatch
covers.


The vessel has not been remeasured and so the new
gross tonnage could not be metered on the new certificates.

With regard to the note in your assignment letter
referring to the periodical load line survey, I may state that
due to the complete freeboard survey now held, this periodical
survey can be considered as covered by the survey now held
and a total amount of fee of Fl. 192.- has been charged as
indicated in our report.

The old certificates will be returned by the Owner.

The new certificates have been endorsed.
