Dear Sirs,

3. I am in receipt of your letter of the 28th instant respecting the steamer "KONSTANTINOS HADJIPATERAS", which has been undergoing Second Special Survey No.3 at your port, and note that as the vessel is now urgently required it will not be possible to arrange for the examination of the lower side bunkers in the engine room on the port and starboard sides, and the testing of the double bottom in way of same.

As it appears from your reports on this case that when the Second Special Survey No.1 was partly held in June 1931 the lower side bunkers in the engine room were examined and the tank in way tested, the Committee will, in these circumstances, agree to the Owners' proposal to defer the examination and testing of the parts referred to above on the definite understanding that these items will be attended to at a Continental port after the vessel's return from the round voyage to South America, but the Special Survey in all other respects be completed now to your satisfaction.

In these circumstances, you will be at liberty to issue the freeboard certificates, and I now await the receipt of your reports on the case.
