With reference to the S.S. "PINEMORE" and the Secretary's letter of the 25th instant I beg to acquaint you that this vessel has been purchased by the Lesreaulx S.S.Co.Ltd and is to be renamed "LESREaulX" with London as the port of registry.

The new Owners are restoring the tonnage opening to its original condition, the scuppers to bilges in the shelter deck tween decks are being removed and the scuppers and wash ports through the ships side are being reopened.

The Owners desire new freeboard certificates to be issued the same to be handed over on completion of the above alterations.

The vessel has been examined in Drydock, some minor damage repairs effected and is now in good order.

The case will be reported in due course.
