I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to see that suitable means for battening down are provided and report accordingly in due course.

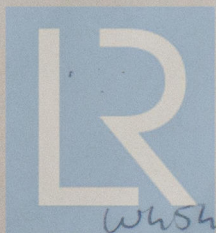
