REGULATIONS FOR DISPENSING WITH TONNAGE OPENING.

1. Tonnage opening in shelter deck aft to be plated over, or as an alternative an ordinary hatch with coamings and battening down arrangements constructed.
2. Freeing ports in vessel's sides abreast present tonnage opening to be permanently riveted up.
3. Scupper pipes from shelter 'tween decks to be removed, the openings in the shell plating below the upper deck to be closed with riveted spigot plates, and the openings in the upper deck stringer plate to be closed by riveted plates.

REGULATIONS FOR DISPENSING WITH TONNAGE OPENING.

1. Tonnage opening in water deck etc to be closed over, or as an alternative an ordinary hatch with covers and battening down arrangements constructed.
2. Fixing bolts in vessel's side should prevent tonnage opening to be permanently riveted up.
3. Copper pipes from water tank deck to be removed, the opening in the hull plating below the water deck to be closed with rivets, and the opening in the water deck etc to be closed by rivets.
