Elektriska Svetsnings A.-B. at Gothenburg attend at their works on the 1st, 10th & 19th October, 1929, for the purpose of inspection and testing by hydraulic pressure three complete sets of steel superheaters, each consisting of four cast steel headers with elements, made for the steamer "BODEN" of Stockholm.

The material of the cast steel headers has been tested by the Society's Surveyor at Stockholm and found marked:-

The superheaters were in the presence of the undersigned Surveyor tested by hydraulic pressure to 700 lbs./sq.inch and found to be satisfactory.

The superheaters are as far as can be seen suitable for a working pressure of 180 lbs.
