

Propellers, underwater fastenings & sea connections.

Main engines:— Nos.1,5 & 6 Port & Nos.1, 2 & 5 Starboard covers, valves & gears, cylinders, liners, pistons, rods, top & bottom ends and crank pins. All Port main crank shaft journals, thrust shaft & intermediate shafting.

Auxiliaries:— Port air compressor throughout. Starboard auxiliary engine (driving No.3 generator) throughout. Port main starting air receiver internally. Forward S.W.circulating pump for M.E. Port F.W circulating pump & cooler for M.E. Sanitary pump. Port lubricating oil pump. Main lubricating oil cooler. Port steering gear Hele Shaw pump unit.
