"RESERCHO"

The Grimsby trawler *Resercho*, of 258 tons gross, has struck a mine in the North Sea and her crew of nine, who were picked up by a tanker, have been landed at an East Coast port. The *Resercho* was owned by Mr. G. F. Sleight, and was built in 1917 by Cook, Welton & Gemmell, Ltd., Beverley.

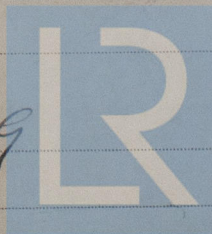
