
Yard No. 24, Freeboard.

After having received your information that the freeboard 7' - 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " has been assigned on condition of that the scuppers in the tween deck be permanently closed, we have immediately informed the owners accordingly, and have now received a letter from them, a copy of which we herewith enclose.

The sister vessels in question s.s. "Valaya" and s.s. "Suddhahib" have been built exactly as s.s. "Malini" and have scuppers from tweendeck to outboard in the same height closed with screw plugs, exactly as shown on the blue print previously sent by us. As those vessels have got a freeboard of 7' - 6" assigned without alteration of the scuppers, we respectfully request that the s.s. "Malini" may get the same freeboard under the same conditions.
