B.I. Liner Breaks Back after Grounding

The British India Steam Navigation Company's cargo liner *Golconda* has grounded in the river at Chittagong, has broken her back, and is considered a total loss, together with her cargo of rice and paddy. The crew have been saved. The *Golconda*, which was a steamer of 5316 tons gross, was built at Sunderland in 1919.
