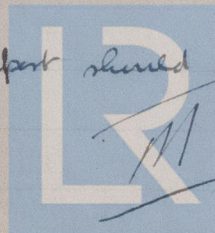
First Entry.

The Surveyors should be requested to state whether the width of Upper & stringer plate is as shown on plans as built, or as given in report, whether Bulkheads are plated vertically or if no whether ~~the~~ thickness of plating is approved. They should state the thickness of keel at ends, and if the widths at ^{in A, B, C & E} ~~the~~ ^{ends} ~~strikes~~ A, B & C are as given in report whether the riveting of butts ^{is} as approved, ^{quintuple} whether the riveting of Bridge side butts ^{is} as approved. It should also be stated the rivets in the treble riveted shell butts are spaced $3\frac{1}{2}$ diameters as required by rules.
