I am in receipt of your letter of the 17th instant respecting the steamer "GIMLE", the contents of which have been noted, and with regard thereto have to inform you that Convention ordinary and timber deck cargo freeboards have again been computed in this case. The ordinary cargo freeboards based on the Norwegian 1909 Rules as previously assigned remain unaltered, but the timber deck cargo freeboards are different and the enclosed certificates have been prepared accordingly.
