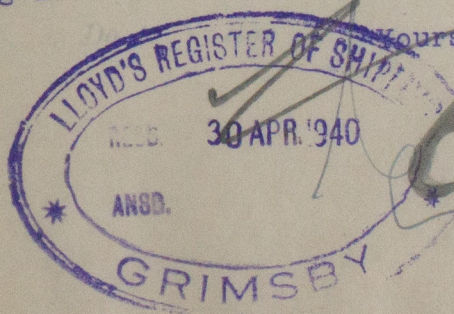
Dear Sirs,

We have your account for £3-3-0 in connection with damage and/or repair survey on this vessel which we cannot understand. There was some internal damage to this vessel's holds caused by the Narvik cargo but this is purely a commercial matter between ourselves and the Ministry of Shipping.
