M. I am in receipt of Mr. Eide's letter of the 28th instant enclosing a plan, in triplicate, of weather deck ventilators for Messrs. Fredriksstad mek. Verksted's Yard Nos. 287 & 289, and with regard thereto I have to state that it is contemplated by the Rule that coamings of the thicknesses given in the Table in Section 26 will be fitted to the point where, in severe weather, the plugs and canvas covers will be fitted. The comparison made by the Builders, therefore, that the upper part of the coaming made 8 m/m in thickness is stronger than the usual ventilator cowl, cannot be held to apply.

The scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended on the plan submitted will be approved, provided they be carried out to your satisfaction.

Two copies of the plan are returned herewith, and the remaining copy is being retained for record.
