REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Condition Survey:-

Now Done:- Vessel placed in dry dock, bottom, stern frame & rudder cleaned, examined, found or now placed in good condition and recoated.

Decks, hatchways, hatches and supports, ventilators & coamings and general equipment examined and found in good condition. Freeboard verified.

Plating in way of ash shoot examined and found in good condition.

Windlass & steering engine and its connections examined and found in order.

Special Reasons List:- Nothing done at this time.

Repairs due to wear & tear:- No.1 keel plate doubled (2-4"x10'-2"x3/8") at aft end.

Port side, shell plate G-2 (from stem) part doubled (3'-3"x4'-5"x3/8").

Wasted bottom rivets (188) renewed under Fore peak & No.1 Double bottom tanks.

854 shelter deck rivets found wasted and renewed in way of No.1.2 bunker & 3 hatches.

On completion of the above repairs, shell & deck plating hose tested & found tight.

All (5) rudder guideon bush renewed: 8 new tarpauline supplied. Other minor repairs effected.
