edge of the statutory deck line

Freeboard ..... 2 ft. 4½ in = 724 mm below the  
edge of the statutory deck line

Freeboard in north Atlantic ..... 2 ft. 7½ in = 800 mm below the  
edge of the statutory deck line.

Statutory deck line is to be marked in accordance with *the British*

*Trade Regulations 1½" = 38 mm above the steel  
side amidships*

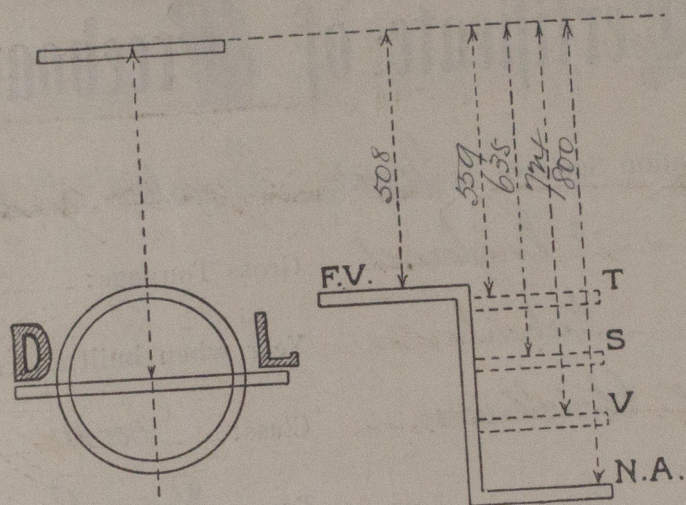
