

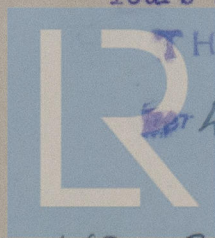

We beg to inform you that the following additions and alterations have now been carried out in order to comply with the International Load Line Convention:-

- 1). Two tarpaulins have been provided for each cargo hatch on Freeboard Deck.
- 2). Wood plugs and canvas covers have been provided for means of closing ventilator coamings.
- 3). Two tarpaulins and efficient covers and battening arrangements have been provided for each bunker hatchway on Freeboard deck and for the bunker hatchway on the Shelter Deck.
- 4). The openings in the machinery casings in the shelter tween decks have been fitted with strongly constructed doors, capable of being securely closed. on both sides.
