We beg to enclose herewith Freeboard Verification Form (V.361) and have to inform you that the following points have been examined and verified viz:-

1. Two tarpaulins are provided for each cargo hatch on the freeboard deck. ✓
2. All ventilator coamings are provided with wood plugs and Canvas covers. ✓
3. Two tarpaulins and efficient covers and battening down arrangements are provided for each bunker hatch on both freeboard and shelter decks. ✓
4. The two openings in the machinery casings each 3'0"x24"x36" sill are fitted with hinged steel doors closed by means of turnbuckles manipulated from both sides.
