

Danish Steamer "SCOTIA"

Class: +100A1

The Danish Ministry of Shipping inform this Office that freeboards have been assigned to this ship in accordance with the International Load Line Convention for ordinary cargoes and timber deck cargoes, and certificates have been issued.

The freeboards for the ship when carrying ordinary cargoes are as follows:-

Tropical.....	706 mm. = 2' - 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ "
Summer.....	795 mm. = 2' - 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ "
Winter.....	870 mm. = 2' - 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ "
Winter in North	
Atlantic.....	921 mm. = 3' - 0 $\frac{1}{4}$ "

Allowance for fresh water for all freeboards  
- 119 mm. = 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ "

As these freeboards are the same as those already marked on the ship and previously assigned by this Society under the 1906 Board of Trade Regulations, it is submitted the following particulars be now recorded in the Register Book, and the Board of Trade advised in regard to the issue of Danish Certificates:-

Moulded depth .....	21' - 9"
Summer Freeboard.....	2' - 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ "
Maximum Draught.....	19' - 4"
