Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 17th instant forwarding freeboard report on the S.S. "SCOTIA", and with regard thereto I transmit herewith the usual printed letters setting forth the freeboards which have been assigned to this vessel.

In compliance with your request I have cabled you this afternoon as follows, namely:-

SCOTIA = Vessel's name

ALHOR) = The freeboard assigned is 2'-9" from top of
ALKUV) statutory deck line to centre of disc.

ALLYX = The statutory deck line is 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " above the steel deck at side.

ALPIX = The other lines should be marked as follow:-
Fresh Water 5" above centre of disc.

ALRIZ = Indian Summer 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " above centre of disc.

ALXYF = Winter 3" below centre of disc.

ALUWE = Winter N.A. 5" below centre of disc.

As this vessel is being built in accordance with the Society's New Rules, I shall be glad if you will state the height, length and area of the bulwark plating, also the total number and area of freeing ports each side of the vessel in each well.
