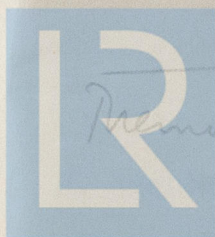
NORA MÆRSK.—Kobe, Feb. 10.—A motor vessel, formerly known as the Nora Mærsk, which was purchased for scrapping purposes, is now under repair at the Osaka Ironworks and will be ready for use in April. The vessel was wrecked by fire in 1936, and was sold for scrap. The Shimatani Kisen Kaisha, which bought the vessel, took her to the Osaka Ironworks, where it was found that the vessel was serviceable. Engineers of the Osaka Ironworks are confident that the repaired vessel will develop $14\frac{1}{2}$ knots. She will be known as Hokoku Maru. † "The Japan Chronicle."
