Dear Sir,

With reference to previous correspondence between us respecting the survey held at Hong Kong by Mr. Pickering, the Society's Senior Surveyor at Shanghai, of your motorship "NORA MAERSK", I beg to enclose herewith for your information a copy of Mr. Pickering's report to the Committee, together with a copy of the repair specification and a photoprint of the results of sighting the deck and keel, these documents having been before the Committee at their meeting today.

It is understood that the vessel has now been declared a constructive total loss, and in the circumstances the case will be submitted to the General Committee on Thursday next, with a view to a casualty record of "Damaged by fire 7,36" being assigned, thus automatically cancelling the vessel's classification.

At the same time I enclose as arranged an account for fees and expenses, incurred in connexion with Mr. Pickering's survey of the vessel at Shanghai.
