The class is subject to indented shell plating and frames in way in No.1 hold starboard side being dealt with at the Owners' earliest convenience.

Action has been deferred for repairs to damaged shell plating, framing, decks, casings, bulkheads etc. in the engine room and the lower and shelter tween decks in way of the machinery space through fire, flooding and beaching and pending receipt of a report from the Hong Kong Surveyors.

~~supplied~~ An anchor and 90 fathoms of chain cable which had been require to be replaced.

The Shanghai Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock at Hong Kong and a complete specification of repairs and renewals established for making good the damage above referred to with a view to advising the Owners as to the practicability or otherwise of repairing the vessel.

The Surveyors state that the hull damage is much more extensive than was anticipated and the bottom is set up to a maximum extent of 12 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and the vessel is hogged and express the opinion that although the vessel may become a Constructive Total Loss the hull can be repaired should any purchaser require to recondition her to suit his own particular requirements.

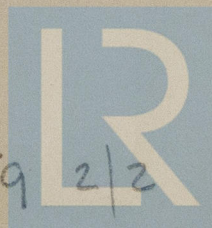
