S. I have to confirm my cablegram to you of yesterday's date as per translation attached, having further reference to the Motorship "NORA MAERSK", which is now being towed to your port after extensive fire damage in the Phillipine Islands.

At the request of the Owners, Mr. H. Pickering, the Society's Senior Surveyor at Shanghai was sent to Zamboanga to hold a preliminary survey of this vessel, and with a view to meeting the Owners' wishes, he has been instructed to proceed to your port to make a further inspection on arrival.


