With reference to my letter of the 26th instant respecting your motorvessel "NORA MAERSK", I beg to acquaint you that Mr. H. Jasper Cox, the Society's Principal Surveyor for the Far East who was asked to give this case his personal attention, has recommended Mr. H.
