With reference to my letter of the 24th instant respecting the steamer "NORA MAERSE", I have to acknowledge the receipt of your cablegrams of the 26th and 27th instant, as per copies enclosed, and to confirm my cabled reply today intimating that, in the circumstances, it will be sufficient if Mr. Pickering carries out the requisite survey both of the hull and machinery of this vessel on arrival at Hong Kong.

Instructions have accordingly been cabled to Mr. Pickering to undertake this duty, and at the same time the Society's Surveyor at Hong Kong has been requested to advise him when the vessel is expected to be ready for the requisite examination.

In view of the above, the further instructions contained in my cable of the 26th instant in respect of the cases of the "SCHARNHORST" and "CHIEN SHE" at Shanghai should be disregarded, as these matters are now being dealt with by letter to the ports concerned.
