Dear Sirs,

I have to inform you that, at the request of the Owner
S. of the motorship "NORA MAERSK", Mr. Pickering, the Society's
Senior Surveyor at Shanghai, was recently authorised to proceed
to Zamboanga to take charge of the repairs to this vessel
consequent upon extensive damage which had been sustained
through fire in the engine room.

It has been arranged for the vessel to be towed from
Manila, where she is now discharging, to Hong Kong, where the
question as to whether she is worth repairing, or not, is to
be decided.

In view of the importance of this case, Mr. H. Jasper Cox,
the Society's Principal Surveyor for the Far East, has been
requested by cable to give the matter of the extensive damage
to the hull his personal attention and to arrange for an Engine
Surveyor with the widest knowledge of Diesel Engines, to join
you in the survey of the machinery.

I enclose for your information a copy of a letter which
I have today addressed to Mr. Cox on the subject.
