Dear Sir,

S. In confirmation of our telephone conversations this morning regarding your motorship "NORA MAERSK", I beg to acquaint you that, in compliance with your request, Mr. G. Pickering, the Society's Senior Surveyor at Shanghai, has been instructed to proceed to Zamboanga immediately to survey this vessel on your behalf. He has been requested to cable particulars of his departure and the name of the ship on which he is travelling to the Philippine Islands, and this information will be passed on to you immediately it comes to hand.

At the same time Mr. Pickering has been informed of the agreement reached over the telephone regarding the amount of the fee to be charged, namely:- £7 per day, whilst away from his port, plus travelling expenses (approximately £20 to £30).

I enclose herewith an account for the cost of the cablegrams etc. in this case.
