

When Mr. Pickering relieved at Manila in 1932 his return fare was £21, and he was paid subsistence amounting roughly to £64 per month.

Dr. Dorey is of opinion that, in the present instance, his services might be charged for at the flat rate of £7 per day, whilst away from his port, plus the travelling expenses, presumably £21.
