S. With reference to my letter of the 22nd October last regarding the steamer "CAIRNGORM", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case before them to-day together with a note from the Society's Glasgow Office, intimating that this vessel is still laid up at Bowling awaiting your decision as to her future.
