Nature of Survey 3rd Special Survey No.3 When due 12.35.

The 3rd S.S.No.3 became due 12,35 and a proposal to carry out same within the year of grace has been agreed to.

Corroded bottom rivets in A & B strakes (p & s) forward require to be renewed.

The vessel was examined in dry dock in August last and has since been laid up, the Owners being undecided what to do with her.

In reply to enquiry the Secretary to the Glasgow Committee now writes that she is still laid up awaiting the decision of the new Owner as to what is to be done with her.

The year of grace expires at the end of this month.

It is submitted action be deferred and the Owner asked to furnish the usual undertaking.
