With reference to the survey which has recently been held on the above vessel at Bowling, I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their Meeting to-day the Surveyors' reports from which it appears that some repairs require to be effected to the riveting in the bottom and the screwshaft requires to be drawn in for examination, the stern bush re-wooded and the funnel repaired.

As you are aware, the 3rd Special Survey No. 3 became due in December last and has not yet been held.

It is understood that the vessel is now laid up at Bowling Harbour and that you have not yet decided as to her future employment and, in these circumstances, the Committee have deferred action for the present.
