This vessel and her machinery were built in 1918 under the inspection of the British Corporation.

With a view to classification with the Society the engines (with the exception of the screwshaft) and boiler have been opened up, examined and found in good condition, and in conformity with the Rules.

The screwshaft was drawn in for examination by the British Corporation Surveyors in November 1931 and a letter has been received from the Corporation confirming this.

In the circumstances the shaft has not been submitted for inspection now, and it is submitted the examination by the British Corporation Surveyors in 11,31 be accepted but not recorded in the Register Book.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is worthy to be classed with the notation LMC 8,32.

It is concluded that a bilge ejector is fitted, but this should be confirmed.
