Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that the steam trawler "CYMREA No.81597 in the Register Book, has been recently surveyed at Hull with a view to classification.

At the end of July last the Surveyors at that port stated that the Owners' Superintendent did not wish to draw the screwshaft, as it had been examined very recently by the British Corporation Surveyors. The Surveyors were accordingly requested to arrange for documentary evidence of this inspection.

They now forward their report of the survey for classification, and state therein that the screwshaft "was examined by the British Corporation Surveyors in November, 1931, at Fleetwood, and that this has been confirmed by the Liverpool Surveyors".

I therefore telegraphed to you today, as follows:-

"Cymrea 81597 wire whether you can confirm screwshaft examined Fleetwood, November 1931 by British Corporation Surveyor and found good condition Stop if possible forward documentary evidence"

and have to confirm the receipt of your telegram, as follows, viz:-

"Cymrea British Corporation confirm screwshaft examined Fleetwood November 1931 letter from them following"
