The new name of the vessel will be "SIR MARK SYKES", the new Owners, Messrs. Farrows Steam Fishing Co., Ltd., St. Andrew's Dock, Hull.

This vessel, which was originally classed with the British Corporation, has now been submitted to Survey with a view to classification with this Society.

This Survey is now well advanced, and it is hoped that reports will be forwarded this week recommending that the vessel be classed 100 A.1. Steam Trawler.


