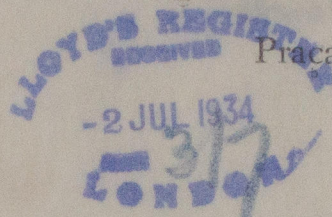

With reference to your classing letter of the 20th April Report N^o.2372 on the above named vessel regarding the equipment and the figure "1" to be assigned, I duly advised the Owners with regard to the case.

They were disappointed to learn the figure "1" could not be assigned and yesterday the Local Agent called at this Office with a number of old British and German anchor and cable Certificates. He asked whether I would go aboard to see if the third bower anchor was covered by any of the Certificates.

I went aboard the vessel today and found the anchor had been chipped and the numbers corresponded to the enclosed Society's Certificates N^o.6310 issued in Philadelphia on the 30th March 1918.

Would you kindly advise me whether the figure "1" and Lloyd's A.&C.P. may now be assigned and also of the equipment letter for this vessel.
