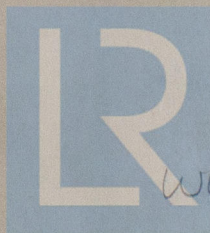
In view of this the question of the screwshaft, which was accepted in October last for 6 months provided the welding was completed to your satisfaction and the shaft was satisfactory in other respects, has again been under consideration, and I have to inform you that, as the shaft is 34 m/m larger than the Rule diameter, the Committee will be prepared to agree to the limit on the shaft being extended until August next before the same is renewed.
