Maschinenfabrik Augsburg-Nürnberg A.G. attend their works at Augsburg on various dates for the purpose of surveying during construction two riveted air receivers of 1100 ltr. capacity each, external diameter 834 mm., thickness of shell plates 17 mm, to the order of Messrs. Establecimientos Herold Lda. of Lisbon and destined for the m.v. "MARIA PALMIRA".

These air receivers have been examined throughout and were found in accordance with the approved plans. They have been submitted to an internal hydraulic pressure of 45 atm. and were found to be sound and tight at that pressure.
