Dear Sir,

I beg to inform you that I have been approached by the Baron Banfield of Messrs D. Tripcovich of Trieste, with a view to his obtaining a certificate of seaworthiness for the steamer "GEORCOS" which, I understand, has been bought by his firm for breaking up purposes. Messrs Tripcovich have taken over all liabilities in connection with the vessel, and I have been informed that the Society's account outstanding against her will be settled tomorrow.

The proposal is to tow the vessel to Venice, and for this purpose one of the Tripcovich Company tugs has arrived at this port, while it is further proposed to have steam raised in the ship's main boilers in order that the steering gear and windlass may be worked, and that the main engines can be used in an emergency.

In view of the vessel's class having been expunged, I have to confirm having sent the following cable, and in the meantime I am arranging for a general examination of the ship and machinery as it is desired that she should proceed on the voyage to Venice tomorrow night.
