

s.s. "GEORGOS"

In August last the Susak Surveyor reported this vessel placed on a pontoon, and, on account of stranding and subsequent grounding, extensive damage found sustained to keel and bottom plating, floors, centre and side girders, tank top and margin plating, tank margins connections etc.

The steering gear requires to be examined and the steering chains annealed. *No repairs have yet been effected*

The Committee subsequently decided to make a record of "Stranded 6,34 - Refloated - now in port damaged" in the Register Book, and at the same time to expunge her class.

A telegram has now been received from the Surveyor at Split as follows :-

"GEORGOS BOUGHT TRIPCOVICH BREAKING UP SUBJECT SEAWORTHY  
"CERTIFICATE BEING ISSUED VOYAGE SPLIT VENICE STOP IN VIEW  
"CLASS EXPUNGED PLEASE AUTHORISE AND ADVISE FORM OF  
"CERTIFICATE".

It is submitted the Surveyor be informed that provided he is satisfied, upon examination, that the temporary <sup>as an unclassed ship</sup> damage repairs are efficient for the contemplated voyage, he may issue a certificate to this effect on Form Rpt.10.
