The Antwerp Surveyors reported in May 1934, that this vessel had sustained considerable damage to port & starboard bow plating, framing, &c., through collision, & recommended repairs be effected before she was again placed in commission.

Action was accordingly deferred for repairs

In reply to inquiry the Antwerp Surveyors stated, in a letter dated 16<sup>th</sup> October 1935, that the vessel had been sold to Messrs Etablissements Van Heyghen Frères for breaking up purposes, & the new Owners desired to withdraw her from class as she would be towed to Bruges to be broken up.

29<sup>th</sup> October 1935.

The Antwerp Surveyors now state, in a letter dated 28<sup>th</sup> October, they are informed by Messrs Van Heyghen Frères that the work of demolition began on the 28<sup>th</sup> October.
