With reference to your letter of the 16th instant, I have to acquaint you that the Committee at their meeting today gave instructions for the class to be expunged and a record of "To be broken up" made in the Register Book. I have to request that you will be good enough to let me know when the work of demolition has commenced.

In reply to enquiry the Antwerp Surveyors have written to the effect that the vessel has been sold to Messrs. Stablissem Van Reyghen for breaking up and that this firm wishes to withdraw the vessel from class as she will be broken up.

It is submitted that in the circumstances a record "To be broken up" might now be made in the Register Book.

The Antwerp Surveyors should be requested to advise this Office when the work of demolition has commenced.
