H Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 5th instant respecting the S.S. "BOMARSUND", we have to inform you that Captain Fostinis, representing Italian Owners, called at this office last Friday and stated that he had an option on this vessel, but that he would not conclude the sale until he knew what repairs would be required to allow the vessel to make one voyage with a cargo of coal to Italy, where she would be broken up. It was suggested to him to get in touch with the local Agents of the vessel with a view to authorizing us to make the required survey but he failed to do so and in getting in touch ourselves with both the local agent of the Owners and Mr. A. Farina's office, local agent dealing with all Italian cases, we are informed that they are not aware of the vessel having been sold.
