S. I duly received your letter of the 15th ultimo, respecting the letters which had been addressed to the late Mr. Robert Mattson, in regard to the outstanding fees for the survey held at Antwerp in May, 1934, on the steamer "BOMARSUND", and in view of Mr. Mattson's death and of the fact that the vessel is still laid up at Antwerp, I have to inform you that the question of dealing with the vessel's class has been deferred for the time being.
