With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "BOMARSUND", I am directed to call your attention to the fact that the damage which was found upon survey by the Society's Surveyors at Antwerp in April/May, 1934, still requires to be repaired; and that the class of the vessel has been allowed to remain in the Register Book only upon condition that the repairs in question be carried out under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors and that the overdue Boiler Survey be held before the vessel is again placed in commission; and subject also to your informing any intending purchaser that this is a condition of the classification of the vessel.

At the same time I have to call your attention to the fact that the fee of ^{Belgian} Frs.2625, and travelling expenses amounting to Frs.120, due in respect of the survey held, have not yet been paid although the account was first rendered on the 3rd May, 1934, and several applications have since been made; and I am desired to inform you that, unless this account be paid by, or before, the 22nd instant, I regret there will be no option but to submit the case to the Committee with a view to the withdrawal of the vessel's class from the Register

Book (which is now being reprinted), as provided for in the Society's Rules, Section 30, page 9, which reads as follows :-

"The class of a vessel is liable to be withheld, or, if already granted, may be withdrawn or expunged from the Register Book in the case of non-payment of any fees or expenses chargeable on account of such vessel".

I have therefore to suggest that you will kindly arrange, without fail, for the account, of which I enclose a copy, to be paid before that date.
