Dear Sir Andrew, With reference to the case of the S.S. "BOMARSUND"

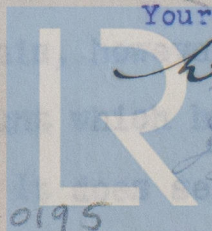
With reference to your letter of the 2nd instant respecting the fee of Frs. 2625.-, plus travelling expenses, outstanding against the S.S. "BOMARSUND", I have to inform you that our usual charge for damage surveys was £ 3, at per, until we received your letter of the 4th August 1933 regarding the increase in the fees for surveys, and from that time our usual charge has been £ 4, at per, per visit, but in this instance Mr. W.E. Wray, who had the case in hand, had to pay three visits to the vessel, two of which occupied most of the working day, and in view of the extensive repairs recommended and the fact that the Master had requested the Surveyor to draw up a typed list of these repairs to enable him to invite tenders, a fee of £ 15, at per, was charged, which I think is a reasonable figure for the services rendered. In fact Mr. Wray discussed the matter with me before rendering the account.
